Onionweed

(*Asphodelus fistulosus*)

Mature Size Knee



Description

- Annual up to 2.5 ft. tall with hollow leaves, from a bulb
- White 6-petaled flowers have a dark line down the middle of each petal
- Flower buds pinkish before opening, growing in clusters at the end of a stiff, long stem
- Leaves are cylindrical and hollow, growing from the base of the plant



- Reproduces by seed and vegetatively from bulbs
- Spread by wind and horticulture
- Native to southern Europe
