Algerian sea lavender

(*Limonium ramosissimum*)

Mature Size Knee



Description

- 1 ft. salt-tolerant perennial with flowers at the end of upright stems
- Small whitish-purple or lavender-pink flowers < 0.2 in. wide
- Low-growing clusters of leaves look like “pom-poms” and act as a groundcover



- Egg-shaped leaves attach to stem at the most narrow end
- Reproduces by seed
- Spread by water and horticulture
- Native to coastal Mediterranean regions

Bloom Period May - Nov

Habitat Salt marsh, coastal grassland, scrub
