By law, before a pesticide can be used in California, it must be evaluated, registered and pass inspection by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the California's EPA's Department of Pesticide Regulation.



Registration

Subject to 120 to 142 separate tests

- 10 years for EPA approval maybe
- Costs 35-50 million
- Now up to 187 million








PCA Demographics
