Scotch Thistle Onopordum acanthium



Biennial herb to 2.5 m Winged stems Heads w/ linear bracts Not invasive in CFP



Illyrian Thistle (<u>Onopordum illyricum</u>)

Biennial herb to 2.5 m Winged stems Artichoke-like heads 2 sites in USA (CA)





Sea Lavender (Limonium spp.)

Perennial herbs w/ basal rosettes and candelabra infl.
Generally in saline habitats
Popular in horticulture
Often invasive

<u>Limonium duriusculum</u> in Santa Barbara salt marsh

Algerian Sea lavender (Limonium ramosissimum or L. binervosum)

Clumping perennial to 50 cm Poorly defined petiole & dense flowers Invades salt marshes (esp. mud flats) In 11 counties in USA (CA)



Spoon-leaved sea lavender (Limonium duriusculum)

Clumping perennial 25 cm
Well defined petiole &
lax inflorescence
Invades salt marshes
In 7 counties in USA (CA)

American Elm (<u>Ulmus americana</u>)

Native to E. U.S.
Common in hort.
Mostly as waif
Serrulate Ivs w/
assymmetric/ bases



Silver Maple (Acer saccharinum)

Opposite, lobed Ivs wijagged teeth
Paired winged fruits
Native to E. U.S.
Along major rivers
Common in hort.
Mostly as waif in CA



Chinese Tallow Tree (Triadica sebifera)

Native to E. Asia
Common in hort.
Mostly as waif
Tear-drop shaped lvs
Spikes of small fls



Common Fig (Ficus carica)

Native to E. Medit.
Common in hort.
Increasing
Lg, lobed Ivs
Bird-dispersed fruits





Golden Rain Tree (<u>Koelreuteria bipinnata</u> <u>& K. paniculata</u>)

Native to Asia
Common in hort.
Increasing
Pinnate or bipinnate lvs
Yellow fls, inflated frs



Brazilian pepper tree (Schinus terebinthifolius)

Native to S. America
Invasive in S CA & FL
Increasing
Bird-dispersed fruits
