- Conservation/T&E/habitat










Federal Funding: NRCS

Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), USDA:

- Focus on private lands, with historic or current Ag use.
- Applicant private or local agency group, tribes, etc...
- Assistance with: technical planning/design, permitting, funding

Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP):Declining Species Initiative

- Develop upland and wetland wildlife, threatened and endangered species, fish, and other types of wildlife habitat
- Recommend this for uplands (non-riparian projects)

Southwestern Willow Flycatcher and Sage Grouse Initiative:





Wetland Reserves Easement (WRE):

- Develop upland and wetland wildlife, threatened and endangered species, fish, and other types of wildlife habitat
- 30 year easement, not restricted to cost list
