Funders <u>rarely</u> have funding 'buckets' for invasives work:

Develop **broader rationalization** for your invasives work:

- Fire risk
- Water impacts
- Access/recreation
- Outreach/social justice
- Climate change
- Conservation/T&E/habitat










Federal Funding: NRCS

- Develop upland and wetland wildlife, threatened and endangered species, fish, and other types of wildlife habitat
- Recommend this for uplands (non-riparian projects)

Wetland Reserves Easement (WRE):

- Develop upland and wetland wildlife, threatened and endangered species, fish, and other types of wildlife habitat
- 30 year easement, not restricted to cost list
