Devil's thorn

(Emex spinosa)

Mature Size Ground

Description

Low-growing to partially erect annual herb with self-fertile flowers produced both above and below ground

- Bur-like spiky 3angled fruits are very hard, light brown, and are pulled underground near main stem as the plant dries up
- Leaves have a spinach-like texture, are heart or arrowshaped, and up to 5 in. long
- Reproduces by seed
- Spread by roads, equipment, wildlife
- Native to the Mediterranean region

Bloom Period May - Dec

Habitat Dunes, urban edges
