# **Tufted wallabygrass**

(Rytidosperma caespitosum)

### Mature Size Knee

### Description

- Up to 3 ft. tall perennial grass
- Tufted seedheads 2-4 in long, densely hairy, very bristly, green to purplish, becoming straw-colored with maturity
- Fringe of hairs at junction of leaf sheath and blade Leaf blades ~ 10 in. long,
  - very narrow, highly variable in appearance, very hairy or smooth
- Reproduces by seed
- Spread by roads, waterways, horticulture
- Native to southern Australia

## Bloom Period May - Jul

Habitat Grassland, desert, roadsides, disturbed sites

#### 2-Minute Removal Pull

### California oatgrass (Danthonia californica) a native bunchgrass

which:

- Is dense and 1 ½ ft. tall
- Has 4-10 in. long, dull leaves
- Slender flowering stalks to 3 ft. tall
