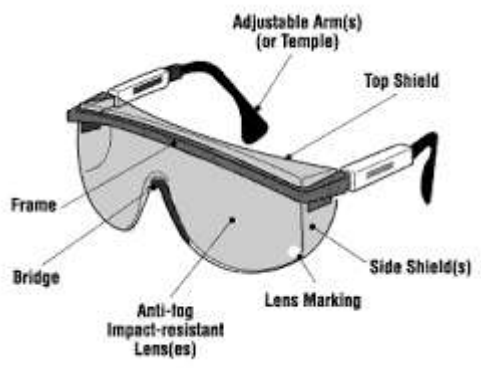














# What's Wrong with this picture?

- Pesticides in the cab of the work vehicle, next to PPE and food
- Not a suitable storage space for pesticides



# What's Wrong with this picture?



- Unsecured Pesticides
- Unattended for 15-20 min
- PPE with Pesticides (CR green gloves)

# What's Wrong with this picture?



Pesticide Storage box left unlocked and unattended, on both sides



# What's Wrong with this picture?

- SPCB Service vehicle parked & unattended at least 100 yards from office.
- Not marked with the business name or "Licensed Pest Control Operator" and their license number
- No posting of pesticide storage area on all approachable sides: all of this needs to be readable within 25 feet

Signs visible from any direction of probable approach shall be posted around all storage areas where containers that hold, or have held, pesticides required to be labeled with the signal words "warning" or "danger" are stored. Each sign shall be of such size that it is readable at a distance of 25 feet and be substantially as follows:

DANGER

POISON STORAGE AREA

ALL UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS KEEP OUT

KEEP DOOR LOCKED WHEN NOT IN USE

## Service Container Labeling.

Service containers, other than those used by a person engaged in the business of farming when the containers are used on the property the person is farming, shall be labeled with:

- (a) The name and address of the person or firm responsible for the container;
- (b) The identity of the pesticide in the container; and
- (c) The word "Danger," "Warning," or "Caution," in accordance with the label on the original container.
