



Directions to Heron Hall at the Laguna Environmental Center

The Laguna Environmental Center is located **at the corner of Occidental Road and Sanford Road**. The address is **900 Sanford Road, Santa Rosa, CA 95401**. **Note: online mapping directions are often wrong – please use the following driving directions:**

From Hwy 101: take Hwy 12 West towards Sebastopol (Go 3.4 miles). At the first streetlight, turn right on Fulton Road, then take the first immediate left onto Occidental Road (Go straight on Occidental Rd. 3.2 miles). Turn right on Sanford Road, and then the first right is the Laguna Foundation driveway.

From West County: From 116/Gravenstein Hwy North, take Occidental Road east towards Santa Rosa (Go 1.3 miles). Turn left on Sanford Road, and the Laguna Foundation driveway is the first on the right.

Please **drive very slowly** on the dirt driveway to avoid dust (during the dry season).

The Laguna Environmental Center campus and Heron Hall are **smoke-free facilities**. Because we're sited on a working farm, **pets are not allowed** (except trained service dogs).

The Laguna de Santa Rosa Foundation's **mission** is to restore and conserve the Laguna de Santa Rosa and to inspire public appreciation of this *Sonoma County Wetland of International Importance*. The **Laguna Environmental Center** is a site where visitors come to learn more about the Laguna de Santa Rosa, a registered *Wetland of International Importance*. It has interpretive signs for self-guided tours, tables and seating for picnics and art-making, a wetland demonstration pond, and bird observation deck. **Great Blue Heron Hall** is our multi-use main building containing nature-related art exhibits (3 per year), gift shop, and meeting space for educational programs. The **restored 1872 white farmhouse with palm trees** in front is our administrative office. **Historic Stone Farm** is a working farm with leased land for several farmers.
