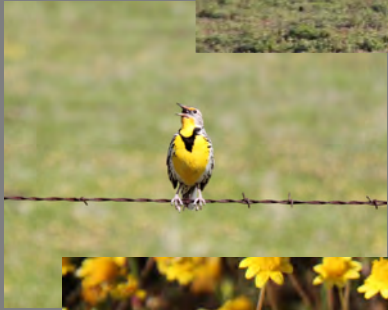




Context of California Grasslands – 1769-present

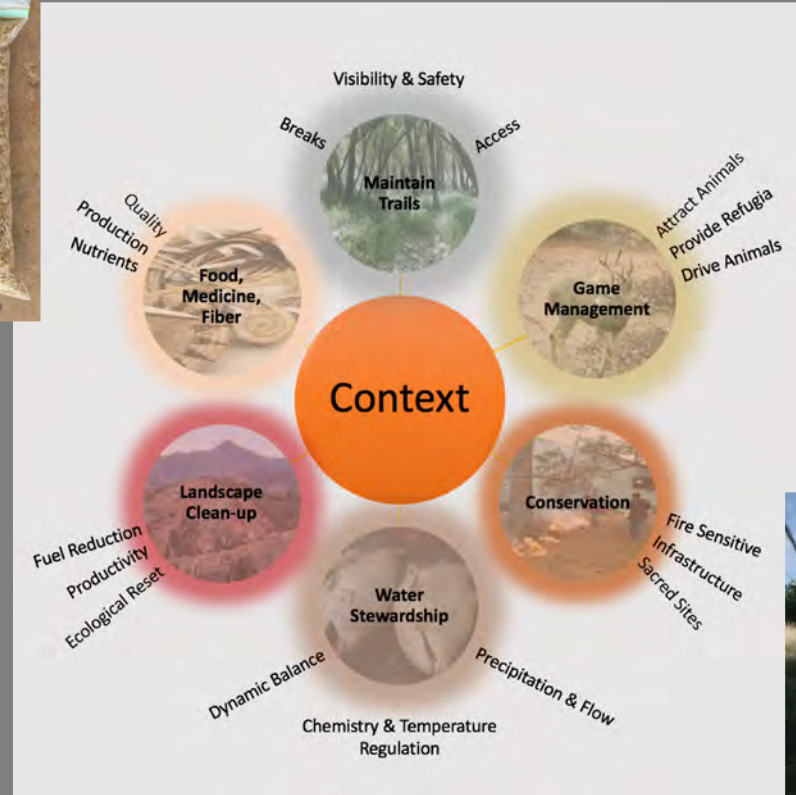

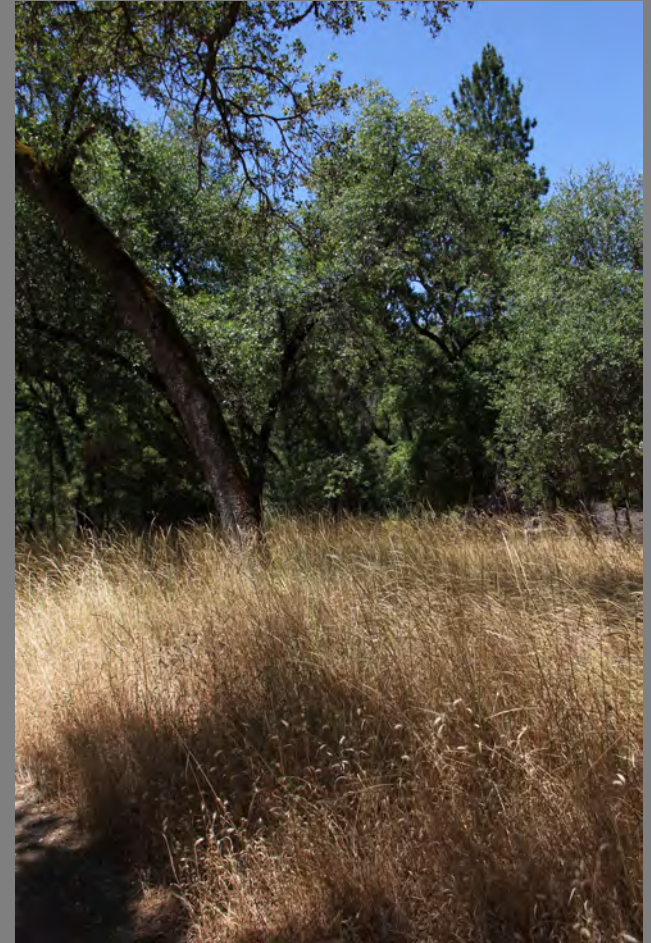
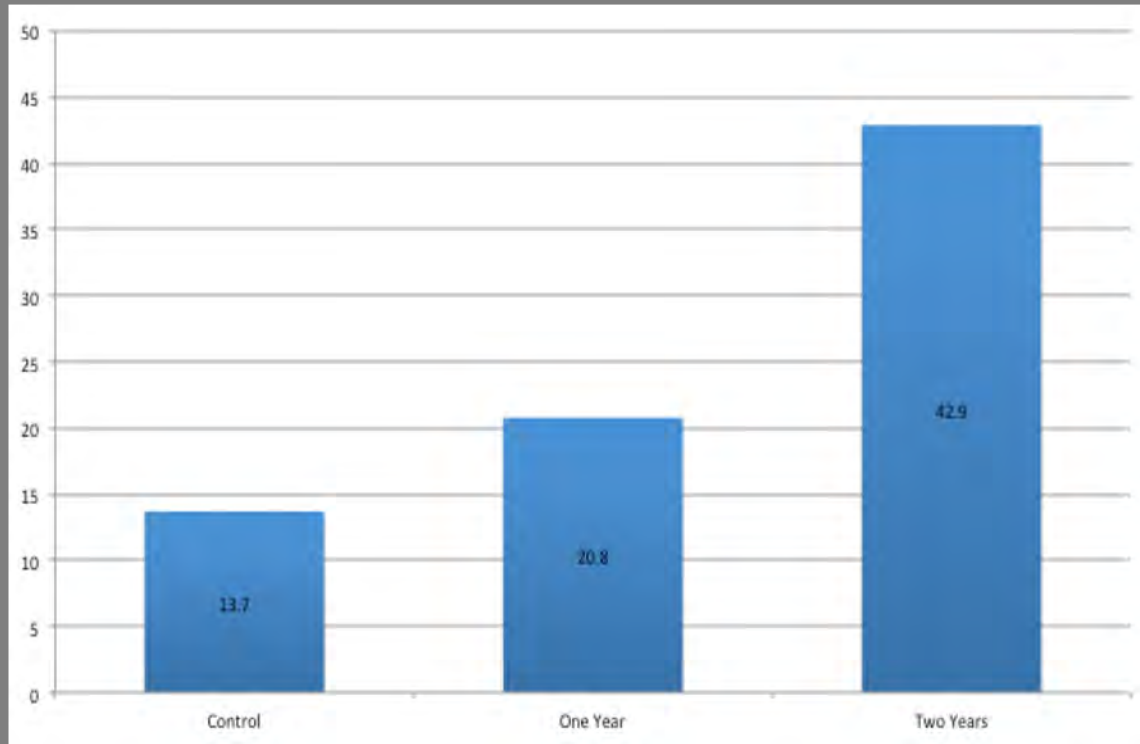

Foothill Meadow: Big Chico Creek Ecological Reserve

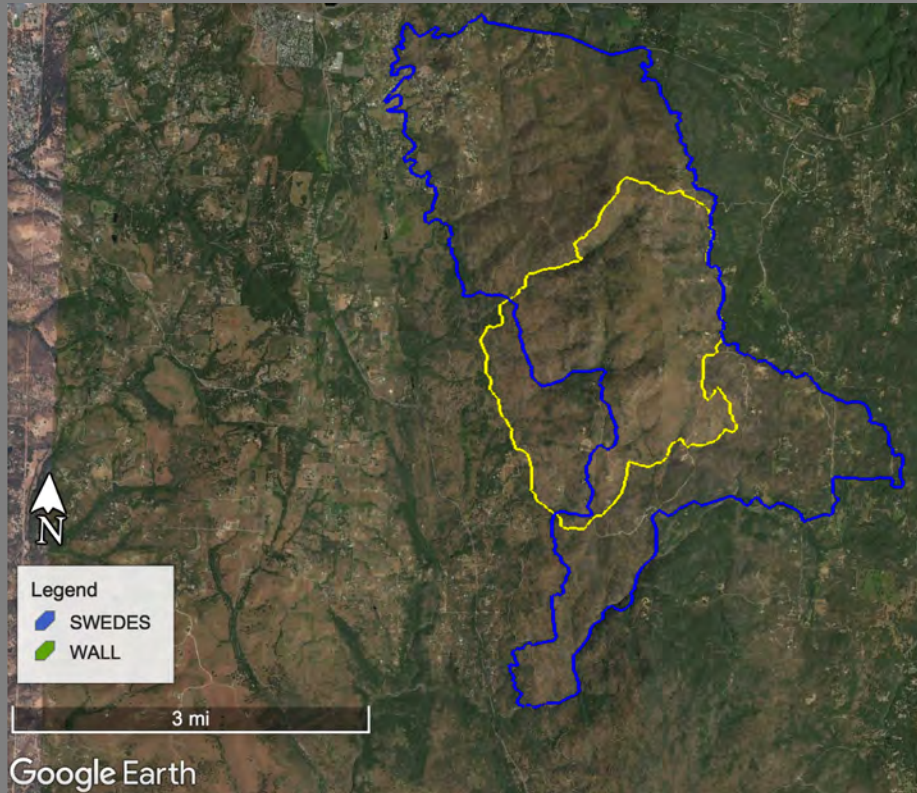


Valley Oak Woodlands: Cosumnes River Preserve
