Yolo County WMA

Yolo County RCD coordinates WMA planning and manages our CDFA grants. We work closely with the Yolo County Ag Dept, which:

- helps with herbicide advice and laws and regs
- connects us with landowners needing assistance
- applies for DPR credits for our WMA meetings

We partner on roadside spray efforts.

Special focus on small populations of wooly distaff thistle, oblong spurge, Russian knapweed, purple star thistle, and yellow flag iris.

FYI: Yolo RCD has a large Arundo control project on Putah and Cache Creek watersheds with funding from WCB.
